INTRODUCTION

Manipur Educational Development and Research Association, Kwakeithel Thiyam Leikai, Imphal West District, Manipur State was established on 25/01/2007 and registered under the Manipur Societies Registration Act, 1989 (Manipur Act No. 1 of 1990) Regd. No. 2760/ID/1993 (M) of 2007 dated 30 -08 -1993. The office of the Association is situated at Kwakeithel Thiyam Leikai, Mayaikoibi Road, Imphal West, Manipur – 795001.

1. Innovation Science & Technology Development and Deployment Programme:

With a view to improve the Science & Technology in Manipur the Organisation has organized 3 months Science & Technology Development Programme for the students of Churachanpur and Bishnupur District these training 500 students have identified and selected for the programme. Classroom Science motivation lecture was conducted inside the programme. Science Exhibition of school students was observed at schools. The programme was conducted by inviting resource persons from the concern department of Manipur University, DM College, Imphal College

and they were given the basic science and its importance in real life and also conducting such type of science quiz programme. The programme was successfully conducted. This programme was sponsor by NCSTC Division,DST Govt. of India.

2. Health camp Programme :

MEDRA organised a Mobile Health Care camp at the Imphal west District, Bishnupur District at Phayeng, Thanga and Khurkhul to provide basic health facilities to the door to door step of the rural SC community with State Health Department(PHC) and health check-ups five school students of Imphal West District.

3. Skill Development Program:

The association had organized 5 days skill development training camp. For the empowerment of youth at Thanga, Bishnupur District from September 27th and 29th 2022. During the program 30 youths were participated. The youth were trained on different skill for future planning and competition. Computer education, Science motivation Program, vocational skill, leadership and morel education were the main discussion of the programme.

4. Food processing training programme:

The Organisation organised 5 day Food Processing Training Programme at Ymbem, Andro Imphal East 20 women participated in the programme. one resource persons from DM College Govt. of Manipur conducted the training programme and they gave how we set up a food processing unit and use the foods in our home. All trainers get well knowledge from the five days programme.

5. Computer and Electronic training programme:

Computer knowledge is one of the most important knowledge in this 21st century. Everything is in connection with computer. To make this aware in the rural areas, the organisation had done a computer training programme for three months

from 1th September to 30th November 2022 at Kwakeithel bazar MEDRA office. This training programme was effective and benefitted many peoples.

6. Fishermen Welfare Development Training programme :

The main objective of implementing this programme is to develop Fishery as means of rural development and educated and uneducated persons of self-employment generation. Dr. Linthoingambi DM College Fishery Professor was motivation lecture to the rural educated and uneducated persons to take up dairy unit for providing necessary training, common facilities work for Centre and Other forward and backward linkage etc. are the main component of the fishery. The organisation is helping the fishermen to gain maximum of the profit from them by eliminating the middle man as well as save them from other market exploitations.

7. Environment suitability Awareness programme:

With a view to improve the degrading environment of the state and to promote the environment awareness, the Organisation had organised “One Day Environment & Ecology Development Programme” at PCC Community Hall, Imphal West District on 12th January, 2023. About 40 participants including community leaders and school/ college students took part in the said programme. Talk and lecture on various issues of environment by resource persons from various concerned department were the main activities of the programme. Tree Plantation and other related leaflet publish by the Forest and Environment was also distributed to the participants of the programme.

8. Biotechnology method for organic farming training programme:

Bio fertilizers have now been recognized worldwide as the life fertilizers for reason of its eco-affability. The Organisation, with a view to create awareness among the farmers organized a number of programmes on introduction and popularization of Bio Fertilizer in the villages located in and around the peripherallmphal West District. The technology of breeding worms is termed Vermi-Culture and the subsequent use for preparation of compost is called Vermi-Composting. Vermi-Compost is a sustainable bio fertilizer regenerated from organic waste using earthworms which contains 1.2 – 1.6 % more nitrogen, 1.8 – 2 % more phosphates and 0.5 – 75 % more potassium compared to farmland manure. It also contains

hormones like auxins and cytokinins, enzymes, vitamins and useful organism like bacteria actinomycetes, protozoans, fungi and others. Hundreds of farmers from different villages were benefited by the said programmes. The training programmes made the farmers totally aware of the facts of hazards of consuming the products of organic farming. The organization promotes Vermicomposting for utilizing in its farming. September 15th, 2022 Promoted Program was conducted.

9. Tourism development programme

With a view to improve the Tourism in Manipur the Organisation has organized 2 days Tourism Development Programme for the youths of Thanga Karang, Bishnupur District these training 50 youths participated in the programme. The programme was conducted by inviting resource persons from the concerned department and they were given the basic of conducting such type of programme. The programme was successfully conducted.

10. SC and ST living standardised counselling programme:

With a view to improve the standard of living and in every way the Organisation keep an eye upon them and conducts various awareness programmes to make them aware of the benefits and other advantages given to them by the Govt. Of India. Many have benefitted and taken the benefits.

11. Embroidery, Tailoring and Weaving training programme :

MEDRA had conducted 30 Days Vocational Training Programme on Embroidery & Tailoring for rural women at Training Hall of the organisation from 12th October to 25th September, 2022. During the training programme, concerned instructor from district industries training centre, Imphal East, Manipur demonstrated theory classes by the way of targeted syllabus of the course and after completion of the theory class, practical classes were conducted which was taught in the training programme. Altogether 50 women from different parts of the Manipur State for each trade were benefited in the programme.

12. Agriculture and horticulture development programme:

With a view to improve the socio – economic status of the rural farmers, ARMS conducted Agriculture & Horticulture Development programme at Thanga Khunjem Community Hall, Bishnupur District, Manipur from 10 January to 15th February , 2023. During the programme experts from concerned department were brief about integrated and mix crop farming of Agriculture & Horticulture items, necessity of soil testing, value of quality seeds, mode of plantation and step by step procedure of cropping etc. The resource persons also demonstrated the modern technique of farming with cropping machines. The programme was participated with 20 farmers of the area and they are also provided high yield variety seeds, fertilizers, PP chemicals etc. at free of cost.

13. Livestock development programme:

With a view to promote the business of livestock the organisation conducted one Day Awareness Programme on the 10th February 2022 at Nambol, Imphal West, Manipur. The programmed was conducted with the concerned department members. It explained that it can be too a way of earning income. The programme ended well and made people aware. With a view to improve the standard of living and in every way the Organisation keep an eye upon them and conducts various awareness programmes to make them aware of the benefits and other advantages given to them by the Govt. Of India. Many has benefitted and taken the benefits.

14. Bee Keeping Training Programme:

Bee Keeping is also a great source of income if it is done in a right way. Five day training programme was conducted by the Organisation at Dolaithabi Pukhao with the interested persons on 8th to 12th February, 2022. Well experienced Honey Local cultivators were also participated in the Training Programme. They share their various experiences for the local cultivation. It was a successful programme. Shri Y. Ibochou Singh, resource person and a state awardee spoke in detail all about the Bee-Keeping enlightening that lakhs of rupees could be earned by means of Bee-

Keeping. He defined BEE (KHOI) demonstrated how to make a Bee Box and how to keep bees practically. He showed at his best level that it was an occupation with which we could earn a lot of income with less capital or money.

An Awareness Camp was organised by KVIC in association with Manipur Educational Development and Research Association (MEDRA), under HONEY MISSION for the year 2022-23, at the community Hall of Kanchikhul, Imphal West District, Manipur on 23rd December at 10.00 AM up to 4.00 P M. The main objective of the camp was to promote Bee-Keeping at Kanchikhul along with the neighbouring villages and surrounding locations.

To be noted that Kanchikhul is located at the periphery of hills and the people here are most interested in BEE Keeping as their occupation to earn income and to maintain their families up to a living standard. The Camp was, therefore, organized for more motivation and encouragement to them with the promotion of Bee- Keeping.

A training cum Awareness Programme was organized for five days from 20-03-2023 to 24-03-2023 at Kanchi khul Community Hall. Kanchi Khul Imphal West, Manipur), under HONEY MISSION for the year 2022-23 the aegis of KVIC. Paona Bazar, Manipur in association with Manipur Educational Development and Research Association (MEDRA Education, Kachikhetl Thiyam Leikai. Imphal. Manipur with sir D. R. Lama representing KVIC, Madam Romila Akoijam Representing scientist, ICAR research complex for NEH Region Manipur Centre Lamphelpat and Dr, S, Subhamin Singh Representing MU as the Presiden Chief Guest and Guest of Honour respectively and Shree Heisnam Subhachandra Singh as the Training Master of the Programme.

15. Arts & Culture Development Programme:

As the need for Arts & Culture Development education has increased over time. For this reason, MEDRA had organized cultural awareness program among the students of schools. Student's programme in arts and culture, will study cultural form

MEDRA was conducted PMEGP Training program under KVIC Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Skill Development. Our organisation conducted 300 students training at various District of Manipur. The PMEGP training program was successfully conducted in 5 months.
